High Point University believes that surrounding its students with excellence will promote excellence in the students. The President of the University and his wife had a specific vision of deep blues and reds combined with the University's deep purple tones to exude a feeling of distinction.

Senior Designer at CJMW Architecture, Carol Wooley, headed the effort for the Conference Center and went through numerous iterations to study the pattern, scale, and balance of tones.
