Carpets re-fit for a Queen

Cunard's flagship liner RMS Queen Mary 2 has recently undergone a multi-million pound refurbishment that features nearly 20,000 m² of Axminster carpet from world-renowned carpet manufacturer Brintons.

The 2,600-passenger vessel was held in dry dock for 25 days earlier this summer for an extensive renovation, which introduced completely new areas to the ship.

Three principles have been key to the glamorous new interiors, which include ensuring the designs

give each area a distinct and confident look and feel, that they are intuitive to use with layouts optimised for guest use and that they harness the heritage of Cunard.

Brintons was appointed by SMC Design and worked closely with Cunard UK to provide luxurious carpets to the 150,000 tonne transatlantic liner that takes inspiration from the original Queen Mary. The refurbishment includes the construction of 15 new single cabins and an additional 30 Britannia Club cabins with Brintons supplying carpets for a number of public areas and suites.



RMS Queen Mary 2 is the flagship vessel of the Cunard Line. Launched in 2004, the ship was named by Queen Elizabeth II after the first 1936 namesake ship RMS Queen Mary. It was designed by a team of British naval architects led by Stephen Payne and was constructed in France by Chantiers de l'Atlantique in 2003.

James Brighton, Marine Sector Manager, commented: "This is an extremely prestigious and exciting project for us, and we worked closely with SMC Designs to ensure its vision was brought to life through the carpets.

"Inspiration was taken from the original Cunard building in Liverpool and designs were created to reflect the patterns, shapes and effects used on floors, ceilings and walls. We utilised Brintons' extensive design archive to find Art Deco influences to achieve the finished designs. "

The Kidderminster based manufacturer was specified based on its reputation for being one of the world's leading carpet manufacturers, which specialises in dynamic and stylish carpets for cruise ships, super yachts, ferries and riverboat casinos, and is renowned for supplying high quality and innovative products that are custom-made for specific applications.
